# **4** DATA COLLECTION & METHODOLOGY:-






## RESULTS AND ANALYSIS:-

#### \* Quality of teaching-learning :-




### \* Assessment of Students:-









As in survey results show that 96 % students said that their teachers usually discuss the performance of various students in their classes. This shows a strong bonding between Teachers and students in this institution.


### \* Teaching Environment of Institution:-
